Category 4 Approval & Community Consultation Update

C29 Metals receives approval for initial exploration activities at its newly granted eastern tenement.

HIGHLIGHTS

- **C29 Metals has received Category four (4) exploration approval on its newly granted eastern tenement #3233-EL~116km² that is contiguous to the highly prospective southern tenement.**
- **This tenement was granted mid-March 2025 and sits to the east and adjoining the Company's highly prospective southern tenement.**
- **C29 Metals is advancing the Category two (2) permit for drilling on its southern tenement #2786-EL South and northern tenement #2826-EL North.**
- **C29 Metals has successfully completed its formal community consultations days at the village of Aksuyek in the Zhambyl region and the village of Aschisu in the Almaty region. The Company has again been given very strong community support and its exploration plans have been well received by our local communities and their respective leadership.**
- **Application for the Category two (2) permit for drilling will commence immediately.**
- **Planning for field exploration work programs including airborne geophysics across multiple tenements is underway.**

C29 Metals Limited ("C29" or the "**Company**") is pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary, C29 Metals Limited incorporated in Astana, Kazakhstan ("**C29 Metals Kaz**" or the or "**C29 Metals Limited (Kazakhstan)**"), has been granted Category four (4) approval for exploration at its newly granted Exploration Licence #3233-EL.

The Category four (4) exploration approval enables the commencement of tenement wide, airborne geophysical surveys, field mapping and soil sampling programs. This recently granted license sits to the east and adjoins the highly prospective southern tenement further expanding the Company's highly prospective multi-mineral Project by an additional ~116km².

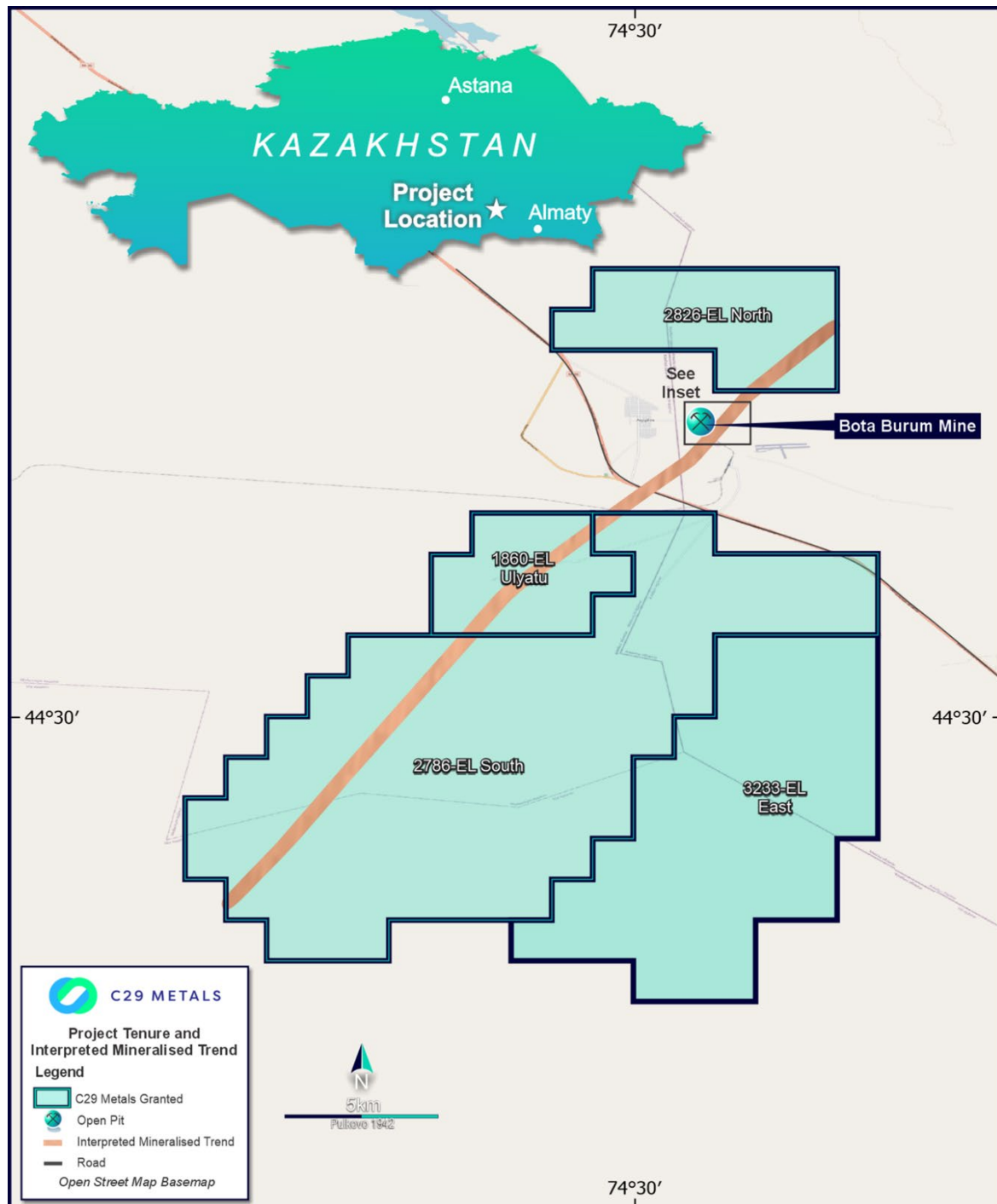


Figure 1: Granted Tenements and Mineralised Trend.

Figure 1 shows #3233-EL, relative to the Company's existing tenements and the interpreted mineralised trend¹.

On 20 March 2024 the Company announced it had entered into a binding agreements to acquire the shares in Ulytau Resources Limited, (refer ASX announcement [C29 Acquires Transformative High-Grade Uranium Project](#)). The transfer of the Company shares is subject to Ministerial approval, on 28 November 2024 the Company was notified that Ministerial approval had been refused. On 14 March 2025, the Company resubmitted the application for Ministerial Approval.
