REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

Terra Uranium Limited (ASX: **T92**) (the **Company**) requests that an immediate suspension of the Company's ordinary shares (ASX: T92) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) be granted in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2.

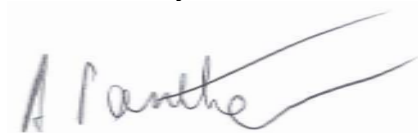
