NH3 Commences WAH₂ Project Approval Ground Work with Fauna Survey

NH3 Clean Energy Limited (ASX:NH3) ('NH3' or 'the Company') is pleased to advise that it is advancing the regulatory approval component of Front End Engineering and Design ('FEED') for its WAH₂ Project with an on-site fauna survey starting today.

HIGHLIGHTS

- NH3 has previously been allocated a 40ha parcel of land by the Western Australian Government¹ in the Maitland Strategic Industrial Area for its planned WAH₂ clean ammonia project ('WAH₂ Project').
- The first on-site activity at the WAH₂ Project location, a fauna survey, commences today as part of the approvals-related FEED workstream².
- The survey will cover the entire 40 ha land allocation and provide data for the initial Phase 1 development and areas earmarked for future expansion.
- The project timeline remains on track with all FEED workstreams targeted for completion by the end of 2026.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As foreshadowed in the Company's 27 August 2025 ASX release, NH3 is today commencing environmental surveys at the WAH₂ Project site. The first on-ground activity is the fauna survey scheduled for 15-22 September and will provide important data required for the approval workstream of FEED.

NH3 has engaged Eco Logical Australia (ELA), an experienced Pilbara survey consultant that previously completed flora and fauna survey work for DevelopmentWA's Maitland to Burrup Infrastructure Corridor. ELA will undertake the work in coordination with NH3's Regulatory Approval Lead, Liz Sully.

NH3's Chairman Charles Whitfield commented:

"It is exciting to see the first work on ground at the WAH₂ site. Meanwhile, all aspects of the project development continue to pick up pace and the workstreams are being carefully coordinated in order to advance the project to meet projected timelines."

1. About the WAH₂ Project

The WAH₂ Project is NH3's flagship project to supply low-emissions ammonia to the decarbonising powerhouse economies of the Asia Pacific, including Japan and South Korea as well as being a source of decarbonised 'bunker' fuel for powering bulk carriers carrying iron ore from Australia to Asia. The project is well placed as Asia's energy transition drives an increasing demand for low emissions energy.
